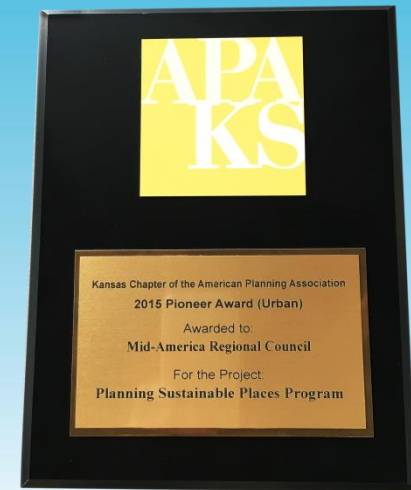

- The Missouri award for Outstanding Public Outreach, Program, Project, Tool, Community Initiative
- The Kansas award is the Pioneer Award in an urban setting

- Program to build on previous regional planning initiatives

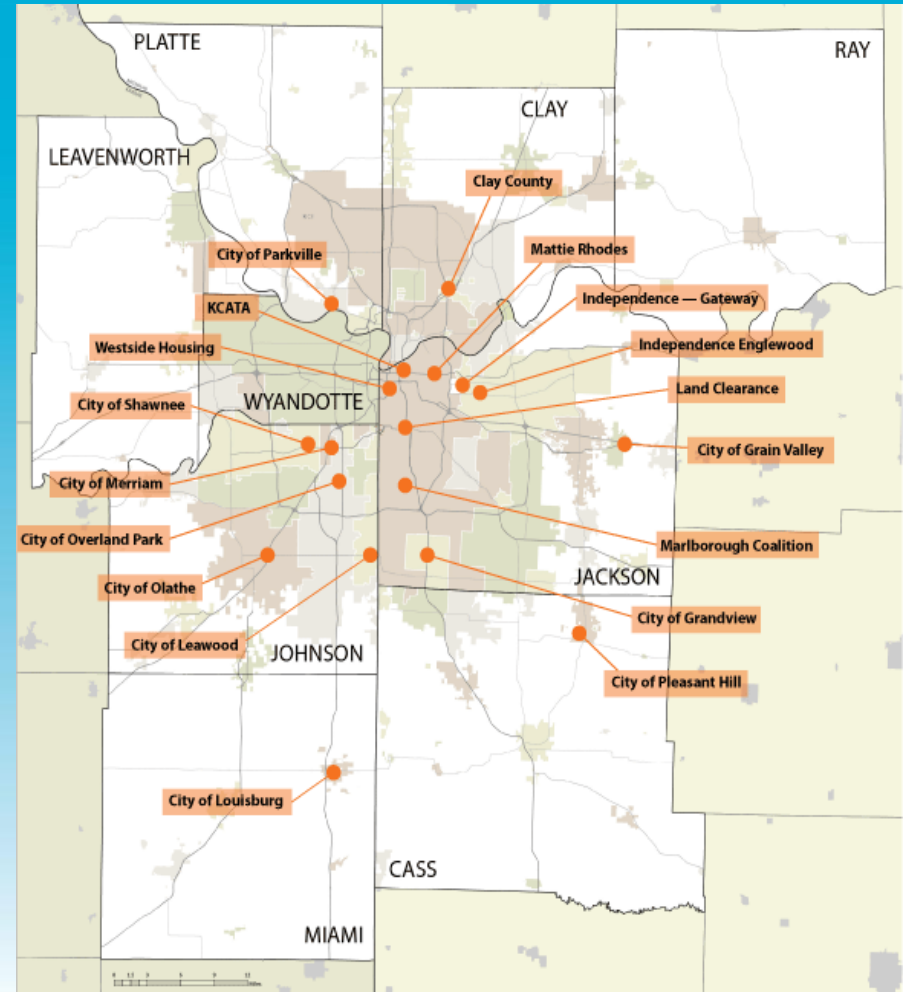


- Implements the MARC Board's adopted policy statement on regional land use direction
- Goal: help local communities advance their sustainable development projects towards implementation



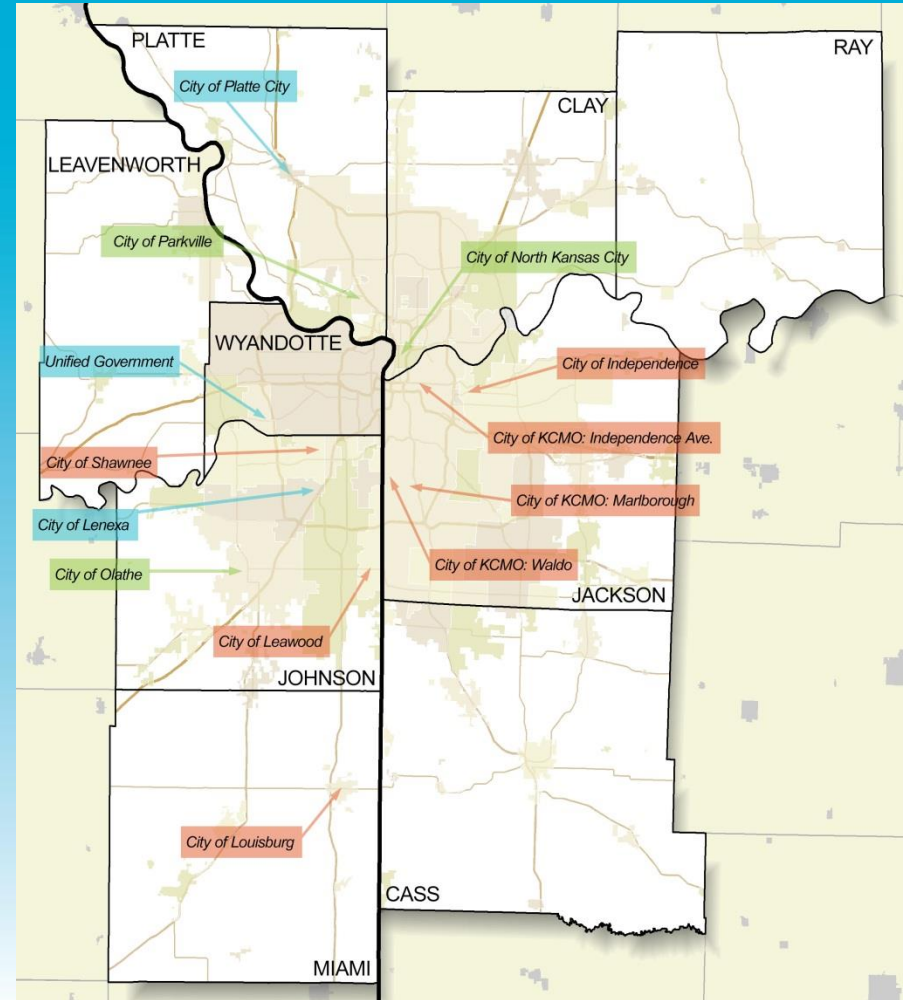
2013 Planning Sustainable Places Projects

- Local governments and not-for-profits furthering local planning projects in a variety of settings
- Wide range of projects including downtown redevelopment, corridor plans, and neighborhood strategies
- \$1,575,000 Funding
- 37 Applicants
- 18 Projects Funded



2015 Planning Sustainable Places Projects

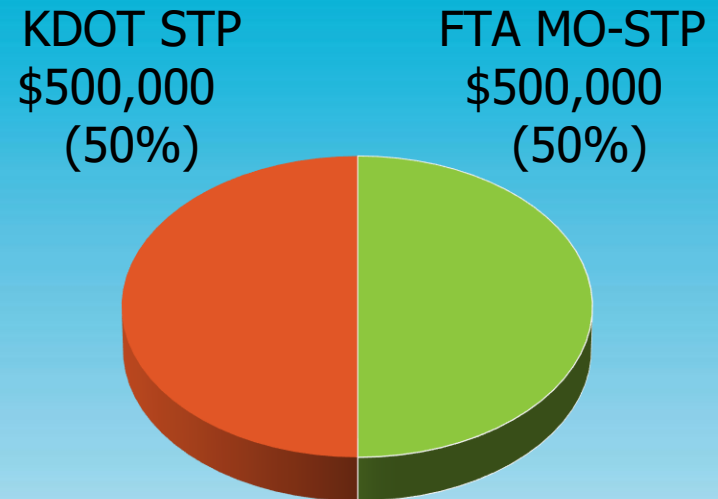
- Projects limited to local governments furthering local planning projects in a variety of settings
- Mix of projects, a portion proceeding from 2013 funding mixed with new
- Covers the spectrum of settings from rural to urban

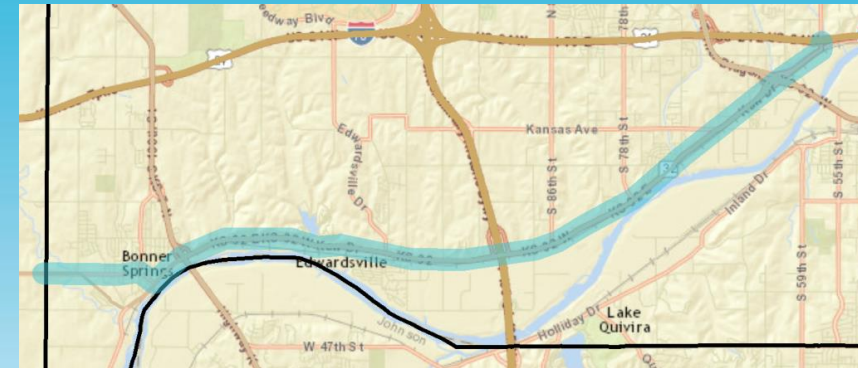

 - Bike/Pedestrian Connections
 - Green Space Planning
 - Complete Street Plan
 - Green Infrastructure
 - Quiet Zone Study

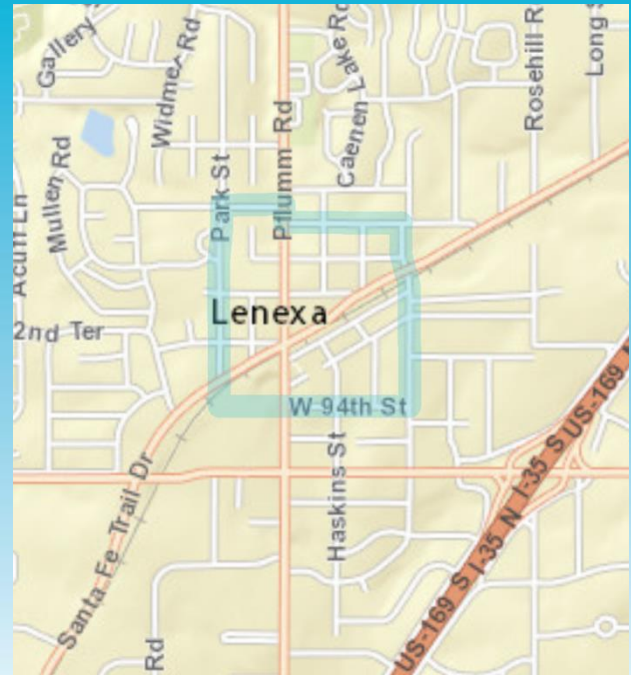

A New Look at Old Town Lenexa

- Project will produce a sustainable places plan that prepares the project for future implementation activities:
 - Provide direction for future land use and improving choices for multimodal transportation
 - Analysis of existing transportation choices and develop strategy to promote greater use of alternative transportation choices
 - Develop design guidelines for streetscape with Old Town

 - Opportunities to enhance natural environment in the study area
 - Benefit/cost analysis of alternatives
 - Typical cross section drawings



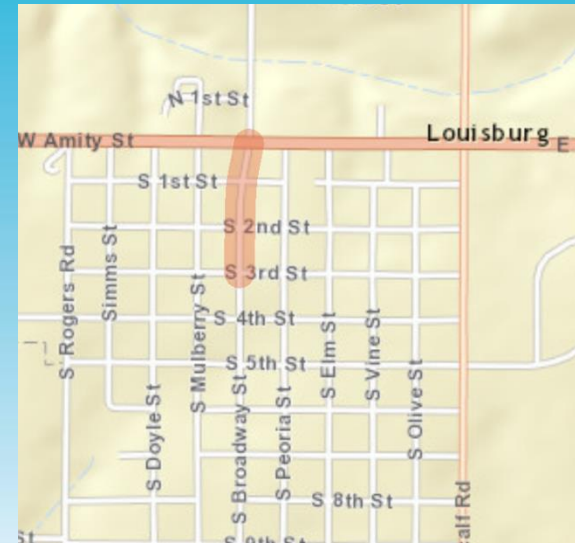
Downtown Broadway Complete Street

Downtown Broadway Complete Street

- Project outlines implementation activities:
 - Identify specific accessibility and infrastructure issues to address
 - Develop improvements to circulation and connectivity to make downtown a “pedestrian first” place along Broadway and expanding outward
 - Create an aesthetic guide to inform the future phase on construction documentation
 - Outline a 5-10 year program for improvements

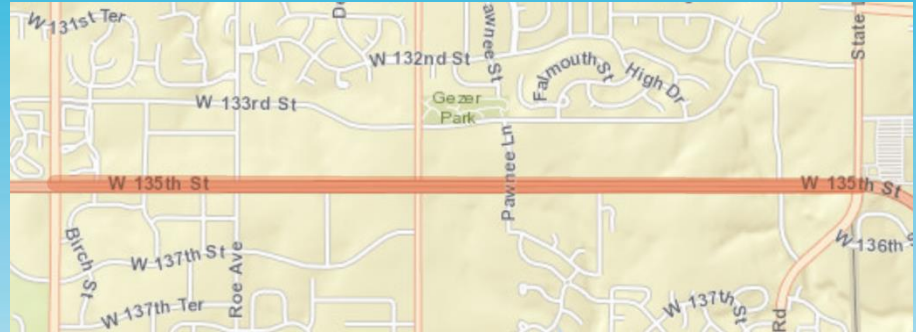


135th Street Community Implementation Plan

 - Assemble environmental preservation plan

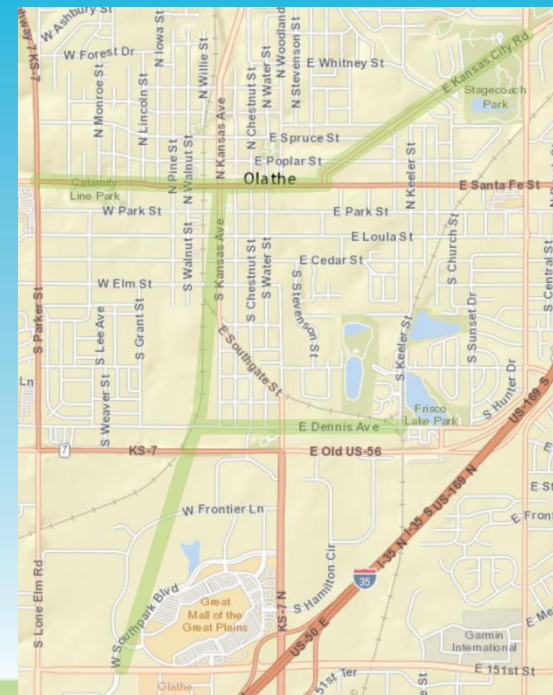


Connect Downtown Olathe

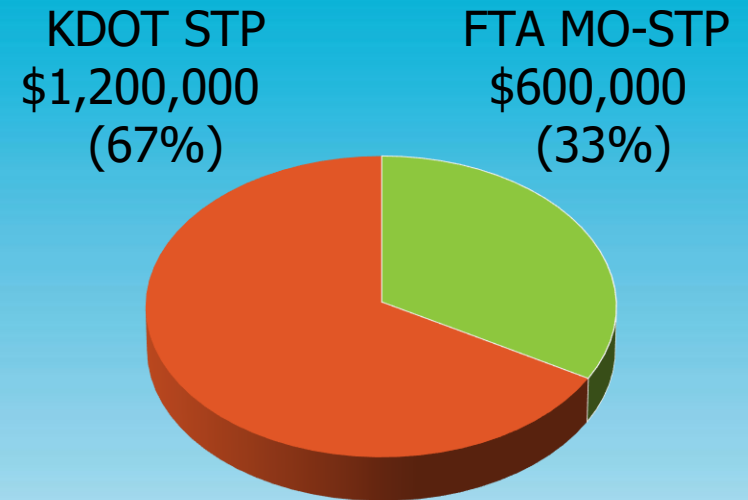
