ISSUE

VOTE: 2015 3rd Quarter Amendment to the 2014-18 Transportation Improvement Program

BACKGROUND

The *Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)* is the region's short-range program, identifying projects to receive federal funds and projects of regional significance to be implemented over the next three to five year period. MARC amends the *TIP* on a quarterly cycle to accommodate changes to projects in the *TIP*.

The proposed 2015 3rd Quarter Amendment to the *2014-18 TIP* includes 43 projects:

- 25 new projects to be added, including, but not limited to:
 - 2 Bridge replacements in Cass County (#790050 & #790051)
 - #490147 – I-29; Pavement improvements from Todd Creek to Vivion Road
 - #690453 – I-435; Pavement improvements from Raytown Road to Route W
 - #690458 – I-70; Pavement improvements from Sterling Ave. to M-291
- 18 modified projects
 - Scope
 - Schedule
 - Budget
