U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Planning and Development – Pathways to Removing Obstacles to Housing (PRO Housing)

Purpose: To identify and remove barriers to affordable housing production and preservation.



Application information:

- Due October 15, 2024
- Anticipated start date February 10, 2025
- Six (6) year period of performance
- Minimum funding \$1M, maximum \$7M

Eligible activities must identify and seek to remove one or more barriers to affordable housing production and preservation. Each proposed activity must:

- Further develop, evaluate, and implement housing policy plans
- Improve housing strategies
- Facilitate affordable housing production and preservation



Eligible activities may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Planning and policy activities supporting affordable housing. Grantees may
 use PRO Housing funds to develop proposals for planning and policy
 activities that support affordable housing production and preservation.
- Development activities
- Infrastructure activities
- Preservation activities



Priorities include:

- Progress and a commitment to overcoming local barriers to facilitate the increase in affordable housing production and preservation.
- Targeting communities that have an acute demand for housing
 - HUD has established priority geography specific to this funding opportunity and also will look at compelling information about the geographies' affordable housing needs

- 2024 Regional Housing Partnership Strategy Committee Goal Setting



Project Focus

Based on HUD Feedback:

- This application's focus area will be Johnson County, Kansas as well as the First Suburbs Coalition.
- Johnson County is the largest priority geography, and the First Suburbs
 Coalition has a history of coming together around topics working to
 implement best practices.
- The rest of the region will still be called out as major stakeholders to engage, share information and materials and work with.



Projects in Application

- 1. Developing a strategy and program to assist communities in reviewing land-use policies, zoning codes and development processes to increase and preserve affordable housing with an aim for implementation and adoption.
- 2. Harmonizing building codes within the region to foster development and preservation of affordable housing.
- 3. Funding development of the Community Land Trust Consortium as described in the Regional Business Plan for CLTs that will provide technical assistance and development of CLTs in the region.
