
DESTINATION SAFE

BY THE YEAR 2027, WE AIM FOR FEWER THAN:

- 176 fatalities per year
- 0.831 fatalities per 100 million vehicle miles traveled
- 919 serious injuries per year
- **4.3** serious injuries per 100 million vehicle miles traveled
- 106 non-motorized fatalities and serious injuries



EXAMPLE STRATEGIES

- EDUCATION: Prioritize effective programs based on NHTSA's Countermeasures that Work ratings or other effectiveness measures.
- ENGINEERING: Create safe conflict points, especially safe-systemsbased intersections by reducing speed, improving visibility, and creating protections for non-motorized road users.
- LOCAL GOVERNMENT: Establish a Vision Zero task force and/or policy within the jurisdiction which includes input from local stakeholders and broad community representation
- MEASURING PROGRESS: Improve crash reporting through electronic submission and training
