- Enrollment data was 76.43% EHS Federal, 90.29% EHS State, 94.87% Head Start,
 87.2% Program Options Combined
- Attendance data was 80.72% EHS Federal, 90.29% EHS State, 82.59% Head Start, 82.73% Program Options Combined
 - Cassandra asked about insurance providing transportation. Lynette informed that Medicare provides transportation to appointments.
 Heather added that Medicare transportation is difficult for people to use oftentimes because of how busy it is. Healthy Blue provides gas gift cards as well. Kaitee shared the resource where people can report grievances of Non-Emergency Medical Transportation.
- Disability data May cumulative was 8.6% HS, 2.1% EHS, and 10.6% Combined
- Disability data for actual was 14.2% HS, 3.2% EHS, and 17.4% Combined

Liz Meng

- Liz discussed financial reports as of April 30th, 2024.
 - Our HS/EHS Core Operating grant has a total budget of \$32,172,048.
 \$12,637,456 has been spent, which is about 50% of the budget.
 - Missouri EHS grant has a total budget of \$1,642,600 with \$1,173,035 being spent. This is about 83% of the budget.
 - Local Community Support, our unrestricted funds, are 94% spent. HRSA MCHB funding is 8% spent.
- Cassandra asked what type of things are purchased with the Local Community Support. Kasey answered that these are unrestricted dollars used when CORE funds cannot be used. Often these are grant closure items for classrooms. The HRSA/P4 Challenge are used entirely for Health Services.

 - Self-Assessment Report & Program Improvement Plan (PIP) Kasey Lawson
 - Self-assessment is done through all three tiers. Tier 3 uses Focus Area 2 as a guide for self-assessment.
 - Some highlights from self-assessment include:
 - Professional Development: We have had 11 participants join the bachelor's degree program through University of Central Missouri that move classroom staff from AA to BA. We are doing Communities of Practice with our staff.
 - ERSEA: We had 10 programs on funded enrollment improvement plans.
 Five of those programs are now fully enrolled. All programs will continue to be on an enrollment plan until September. The focus is on enrollment.
 - Health and Nutrition: Excelsior Springs KidsCare clinic opened in November. Access to Medicaid is one of our largest commitments.
 - Mental Health and Disability: All our programs moved to DECA program.
 We will continue partnerships with Frist Steps and school districts to increase disability in Early Head Start.
 - Alex asked what DECA stood for. DECA is the Devereux
 - Education: We will be focusing on family style dining next year.
 - Molly asked what this looks like, Kasey informed that family style dining is when the food is placed in the center in larger portions.
 The table is set, they feed themselves, and pass the food around to each other.
 - Family and Community Engagement: Parent Café has been a huge success with most programs participating. The goal is use parent voice model to encourage further engagement.







- Environmental Health and Safety: Lead testing was a major project this past year. We will be developing an initiative to renew and engage child supervision.
 - Molly asked if lead testing results were public information. Kasey said they could put a report together of how it went and what improvements were made. The focus was on water testing this past year. This next year MARC Head Start will go back to also test the paint.
- Fiscal: We were able to combine the CORE budget with our Expansion grant. Work towards finalizing budget in August.

Agenda Item: Request for Approval June 2024

ISSUE:

VOTE/REPORT: Authorize submission of Head Start/Early Head Start grant to the Administration for Children & Families for the continued support of the Head Start/Early Head Start Program.

BACKGROUND:

On April 29, 2024, the Administration for Children and Families announced \$32,918,852.00 for the second year of the non-competitive five-year grant award continuation of the Head Start/Early Head Start Program. By August 1, 2024, MARC Head Start is required to submit the grant application for the upcoming budget period of November 1, 2024, to October 31, 2025.

MARC Head Start proposes to continue supporting the enrollment 1,793 Head Start (HS) and 557 Early Head Start (EHS) in programs managed by 17 direct service providers (DSPs) in Clay, Jackson and Play Counties and pass through the funding to the DSPs as indicated in the chart attached.

Individual contracts with the DSPs are reimbursed at an annual per-child rate based on their level of service (Tier 1, 2, and 3) and program options (HS and/or EHS, as well as center-based or home-based). The total amount of annual funding available is \$32,918,852. Included in the total are funds to support program operations, training, and technical assistance. MARC non-personnel costs are budgeted to support contracts for specialized services for staff and families covering mental health and disabilities, education, health and nutrition, professional development, and family engagement services.

ISSUE:

VOTE: Approve key agency contracts to provide Early Head Start services through the State Early Head Start grant.

BACKGROUND:

On June 6, 2024, the State of Missouri through MissouriBUYS Statewide eProcurement System provided a notice of contract renewal for the upcoming budget period of 7/1/2024 - 6/30/25 for MARC's Early Head State Grant. MARC proposes to continue funding for the 103 enrollment slots in the Early Head Start State Program and pass through most of the funding (99%) to the following direct service providers: Independence School District and Operation Breakthrough.

MARC was awarded the contract on June 6, 2024.

BUDGET CONSIDERATIONS:

The total amount of annual funding available is \$1,642,850.00. Included in this total is \$16,340 in funds to support program operations and training and technical assistance. The chart below describes the allocation of funding and slots for each agency.

ISSUE:

VOTE: Approve MARC Head Start's proposal to make changes to the Early Head Start/Head Start Enrollment for 2024-2025 to accommodate closure of EarlystART North.

BACKGROUND:

In July of 2023 EarlystART North had to close abruptly due to sustainability of staffing and financial burden. As part of the annual enrollment planning process, each of MARC's Direct Service Providers (DSP) were asked to submit their requests for changes in enrollment and program options by January of 2024. Programs were asked to consider if changes were needed in program hours, length of day, number of days per year, and number of Head Start or Early Head Start slots to be served. DSP agencies were asked to include data such as the previous year's enrollment and waitlist information and community data that would support the need for the proposed changes.

A request for proposal was also released by MARC in February 2024 to seek a partner in Platte or Clay counties. After the completion of the request for proposal no partner was found.

MARC is recommending approval of changes in enrollment for the following DSP agencies:

- Ability KC- Reduce Early Head Start enrollment to accommodate financial stability, changes in program mission to serve +2 student enrollment.
- EarlystART-Reduce Early Head Start and Head Start enrollment to accommodate staffing crisis and financial stability.
- Emmanuel Family and Child Development Center- Add Early Head Start enrollment to accommodate increased full day programming.
- Grandview School District- Increase Head Start enrollment to better meet community needs.
- Guadalupe Centers-Increase Head Start enrollment to better meet the community needs.
- Learn a Lot Academy Increase Early Head Start enrollment in Jackson County to better meet community needs.

BUDGET CONSIDERATIONS:

Contracts for individual agencies will be revised based on these changes. See the below documents for the details of changes in slots and contract amounts.
